2. Seating: The pictures show a new style of bench and the bench used in Eign Gate (incorporating a backrest for High Town). These could be used in High Town, or the existing seating could be refurbished and re-used. Please select your preferred option.

4. Cycle racks and bollards: The intention is to continue with the cycle racks used in Eign Gate. A simple stainless steel bollard would also be used. Using common items will simplify replacement and maintenance. Pictures of these are shown alongside. If you have any comments on this choice please note them below.

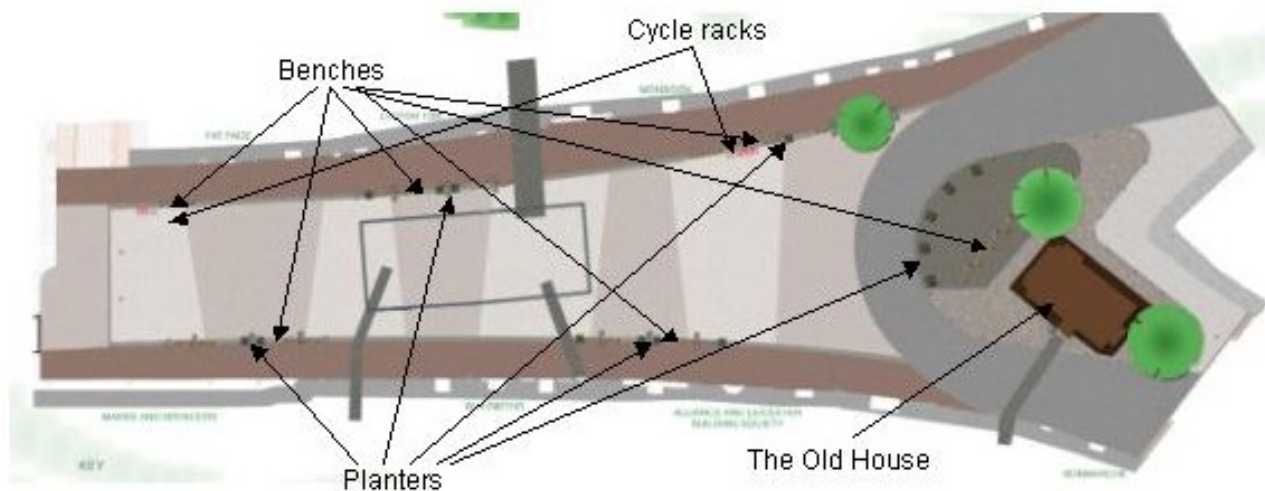
