

DS and JP who are both SIPs declared an interest in SIP.

Group members considered the proposals for the 2011 – 2012 allocations.

CB highlighted some examples:

- Child Death Overview Panel – low scoring – propose to cut
- Children's Trust Funds – also low scoring but proposed to maintain funding

The Group agreed to use the prioritisation grid tool flexibly and to evaluate using the tool as a basis but also consider the context and particular need groups, for example Looked After Children. DS described this as compassionate decision making.

Consideration to be given as to whether Looked After Children have access to other funds or should receive more to help them when they leave care. Better understanding of what is included under Care Matters is needed. It may be more appropriate to give more directly to LAC through Children Trust Funds.

PSA and Extended Schools, Targeted Family Support to be scored separately.

£515k – DS and JP suggested that decisions on how to allocate across phases should be made by negotiation between school improvement service and schools.

Group requested more details on 14-19 and Connexions as to requirements and way forward pending changes in government policy.

Multi-agency working with families/parent support/FIP – needs joining up more as various areas within ABG to support this.

The group discussed engaging schools more in commissioning services e.g. parenting, emotional healthy and well-being. Schools are aware of needs of their population and need to gather this information and share it.

Scoring and allocations based on 2008-2011 Children & Young People's Plan but will need to review or weight activities as to whether these map to new priorities. Otherwise could impact on investment in new priorities and initiatives.

Generally the group felt that the prioritisation grid tool was a good start but would need to be amended e.g. weight for Looked After Children
