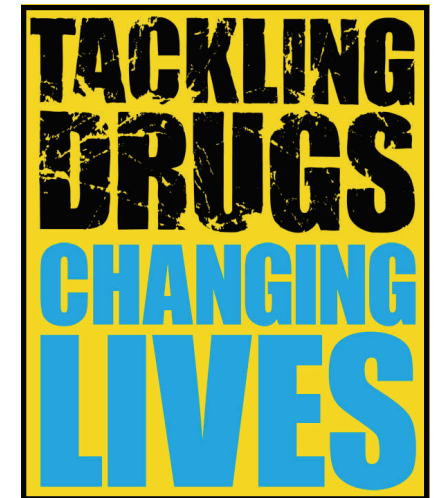

What Is DIP?

DIP is a small dedicated team of Tier 2 Criminal Justice drug workers. We work with people within the criminal justice system who experience problems with drug use.

We provide:

Through Care

From arrest through to sentencing

After Care

Support pre and post prison release

Out of hours advice / support line

24 hours a day



DIP also works in association with Family Drug Support, providing confidential support for families, who are concerned about possible or actual drug use. This allows them to deal with the situation confidently and constructively for the benefit of the whole family.
