



REMOVAL OF BULKY DOMESTIC ITEMS

Herefordshire Council encourages the reuse of furniture and electrical items. There are a number of organisations across the county who will collect good condition furniture and unwanted electrical items from you. For more information please see our 'A guide to reuse' leaflet or visit www.wastemissionimpossible.org.uk

Herefordshire Council also operates a service for the removal of bulky items of household waste.

Free standing bulky domestic items or appliances which exceed 25 kilograms in weight or which do not fit or cannot be fitted into a domestic bin fall under this collection service. Please note, only items which can be lifted by a maximum of 2 people will be collected. (Please see reverse for examples of acceptable items).

The cost for this service is £15.00 for the first three items, then £5.00 extra for each individual item thereafter. To take advantage of this service please complete this form and return it to the address shown below, **TOGETHER WITH THE REQUIRED PAYMENT.** NB This service is not available to commercial businesses.

Payments received by 12 noon on Friday will result in your collection taking place the next week. You will be informed whether your collection will take place on **Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday depending on which area of the county you are in.** Collections are made between the hours of 9.00am and 4.00pm.

All items to be collected must be listed on this form and should be placed in an accessible position, at the front of your property where possible. **ANY ITEM NOT LISTED WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.**

DOMESTIC/HOUSEHOLD BULKY ITEMS

A bulky domestic item describes any **free standing** household item or appliance. As a general guide items that are eligible for collection under this description are those which a householder would reasonably expect to take with them when moving house. Items not eligible for collection under this service are those you would reasonably expect to find when moving into a house.

The following is not a comprehensive list, but is intended to act as a guide:
