THE BARGATES (LEOMINSTER) AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT AREA (NITROGEN DIOXIDE) ORDER 2006

ORDER DESIGNATING AN AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT AREA

Whereas the County of Herefordshire District Council (“the Council”), having caused to be conducted a review and assessment of air quality in Herefordshire, is satisfied that the air quality objective in respect of the nitrogen dioxide annual mean specified in the Air Quality (England) Regulations 2000 is unlikely to be achieved in the area described in the schedule below by reason of projected exceedance of the objective.

The Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995 hereby makes the following order:

1. The area edged blue on the attached map which forms part of this Order and described in the schedule below is designated an Air Quality Management Area and shall be known as “The Bargates (Leominster) Air Quality Management Area (Nitrogen Dioxide)”.
2. The Bargates (Leominster) Air Quality Management Area (Nitrogen Dioxide) is an air quality management area in relation to nitrogen dioxide only.
3. This Order may be cited as “The Bargates (Leominster) Air Quality Management (Nitrogen Dioxide) Order 2006”.
4. This Order shall come into force on 1st March 2006 and shall remain in force until varied or revoked by subsequent order.

Schedule

The Bargates (Leominster) Air Quality Management Area (Nitrogen Dioxide) incorporates the area around the traffic junction where the A44 road (known as “Bargates”) meets with Dishley Street and Cursneh Road in Leominster, as delineated in blue on the map attached to this order.
