Community led projects through the Herefordshire-wide Community Projects Grant.

Support for community led planning via the Parish and Community Plan Grant  
Support for Community Buildings with grants for capital projects, improvements and feasibility studies through the Community Buildings Grant.

Specific assistance for young people led projects in Herefordshire, through the delivery of the Youth Opportunities Fund and the Youth Capital Fund.

The Community Regeneration Team supports the development of stronger, more sustainable, enterprising and inclusive communities in Herefordshire.

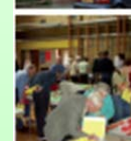

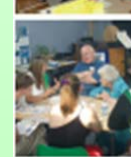

## Voluntary & Community Sector

The team provides advice and support to ensure best practice in community development across the County and facilitates the Herefordshire Community Development Partnership.

We facilitate the community development workers forum which meets on a bi-monthly basis and provides a meeting place for people working within community groups to swap skills, share up-to-date information and discuss community development work in Herefordshire.

We are responsible for managing the Council's relationship with the voluntary and community sector and acts as the central liaison point, to those organisations which in turn provide support to other community and voluntary groups. It provides funding support to a number of voluntary organisations which provide services across the County.

The team is also responsible for leading on the Herefordshire Compact and supporting Codes of Good Practice that set out the shared principles and commitments to the way we work together.

## Parish Council Liaison & Rural Services

This service acts as a first point of contact for members of the public wishing to contact their Local Town or Parish Council.

The Parish Council Liaison Officer liaises between Town and Parish Councils and Herefordshire Council on all aspects of community life. The Officer works closely with the Herefordshire Association of Local Councils (HALC).

The service also acts as a central point of contact for Parish Councils and Parish Planning Groups wishing to embark on a parish plan.

We also liaise with service providers within Herefordshire Council to advise Parish Planning Groups on specific issues relating to the implementation of their action plans.

We also provide support to a wide range of rural services including village shops, post offices and other community facilities. We support communities to identify their needs and to develop projects to meet those needs.
