

MIRA - (the Migration and Integration in Rural Areas Project)



The aim of the MIRA project is to alleviate pressure across public services and ultimately lead to improved community integration. Funding for the project has come from the Migration Impact Fund - a national pot of money which comes from the levy migrants pay to the government when they enter the country. The MIRA project is only able to assist foreign nationals who are in the UK legally.

The Homelessness & Housing Options Service can provide emergency support to foreign nationals. We have a dedicated "MIRA Emergency Support Officer" who can support foreign nationals to find work and/or housing, and improve their integration into the Herefordshire community.
