Notice is hereby given that Herefordshire Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers proposes to make the above-named Order, the effect of which will introduce the following:

#### 30 mph speed limit

#### C1127

From its junction with the A49 for a distance of 328 metres in an easterly direction.
