From a point 590 metres north of the junction with the A438, Kings Acre Road, for a distance of 20 metres in a northern direction.

The County of Herefordshire District Council ("known as Herefordshire Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (referred to as "the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into operation on the \_\_\_\_\_ 2011 and may be cited as the as the Herefordshire Council (BR5067 Huntington Court Railway Bridge) (18 Tonnes Weight Restriction) Order 2011
2. Save as provided in Article 2 and 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform (as and when authorised by statute), cause or permit any vehicle, the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 18 tonnes to proceed along the lengths of road as stated in the Schedule hereto and as shown for identification purposes only on the attached plan.
3. In this Order "maximum gross weight" shall have the same meaning as in the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002. and Civil Enforcement Officer" means a person appointed in accordance with the provisions of Section 76 Traffic Management Act 2004.
4. References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof.

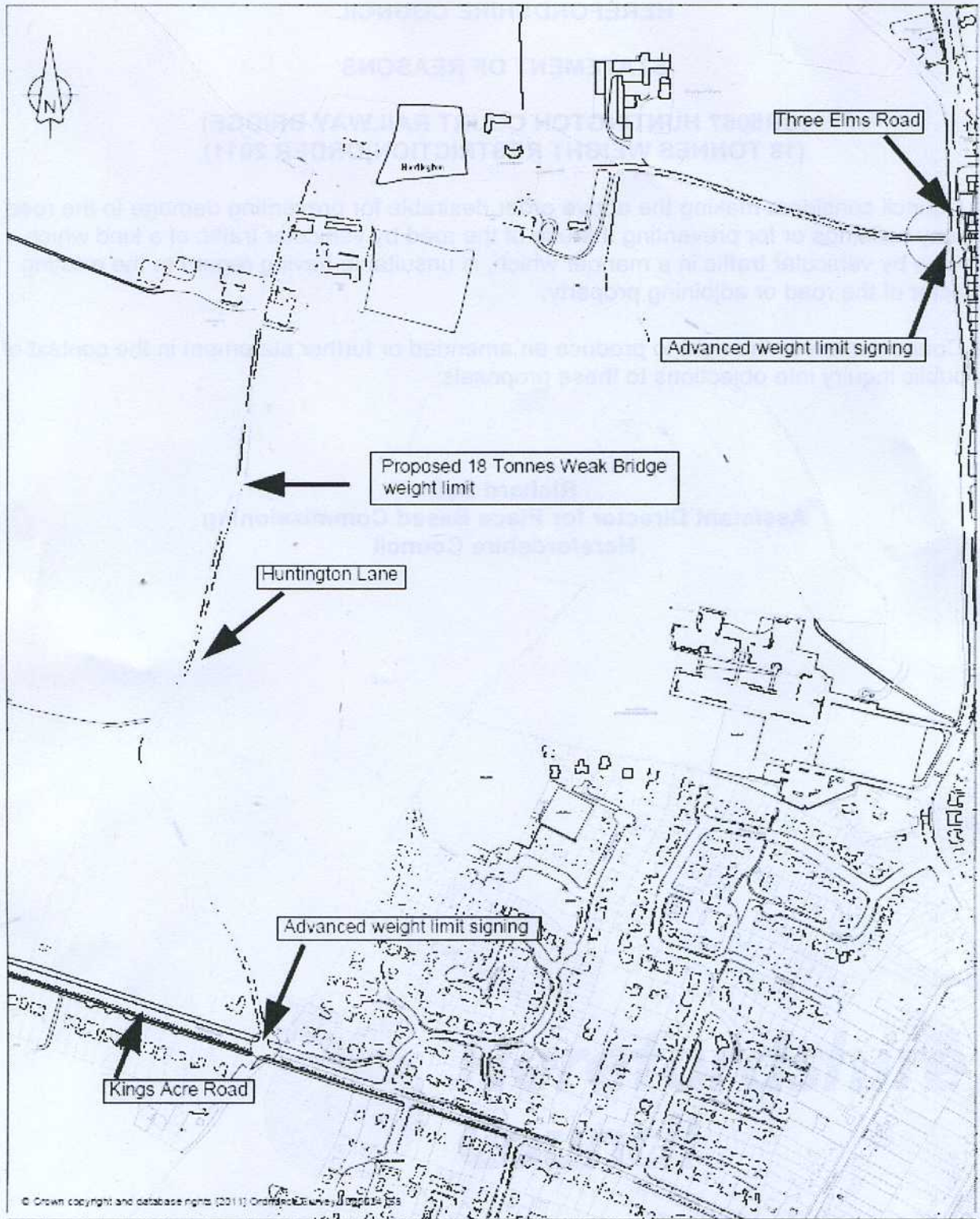
