NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

(A4103 ROMAN ROAD HEREFORD) (SPEED DE-RESTRICTION) ORDER 2011

Notice is hereby given that the Herefordshire Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under section 82(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers proposes to make the above-named Order, the effect of which will revert, notwithstanding the erection of street lighting, the length of road described below to the national speed limit for a single carriageway road (presently 60mph) :-

A4103, Roman Road, Hereford:-

From a point 70 metres west of its junction with the centre line of the access road to the livestock market, to a point 81 metres east of that junction. A total distance of 151 metres.
