Bodenham Flood Protection Group

This self-help group, the Bodenham Flood Protection Group (BFPG), was instituted as a sub-committee of the Parish Council and was formally established on 19 August

2008. It now has its own Constitution and its own funding (held within the Parish's account), an elected committee representing each area of the Village, and a membership of nearly 50 volunteers. It meets on the last Tuesday of every month, with the exception of December, and its meetings (which are regularly attended by about 30 members, but are also open to the public) are formally minuted, the Minutes being passed to the Parish Clerk to form part of the Parish's records. A report on the Group's activities is also presented to the Parish Council at each of the latter's monthly meetings. The real work of the Group is, however, carried out at working party sessions during which members gather to carry out such tasks as clearing drains and culverts, removing silt build up around flap valves, cutting back vegetation encroaching on watercourses, and filling sandbags. These sessions, which are normally attended by at least 12-15 members, are usually held every alternate Friday evening from 6.00 p.m. onwards when daylight allows, *i.e.* between April and October. Work is, of course, also carried out at other times, should the need arise.

## Cross Keys Flood Action Group

Founded in January 2008 in response to local flooding in July 2007 and a near miss in January 2008. Committee of 6 led by Jackie Bremner. Representing all at risk of flooding in the local vicinity, centred on Withington Marsh. Successful in winning the first Defra grant awarded to Herefordshire for Household level Flood protection and Resilience, which has been successfully implemented for 22 homes. Group nominated for the 2011 Pride of Herefordshire Award for “Environmental Champion”.

## Uckingham Flood Action Group



### A SHORT HISTORY OF UCKINGHALL FLOOD ACTION GROUP OR ..... U.F.A.G. AS THEY ARE FONDLY KNOWN!

The hamlet of Uckingham is situated approximately half a mile from the River Severn between Upton upon Severn and Tewkesbury and is home to around fifty properties. The village has a history of flooding; 1947, 69, 94 and 2000 but the flood levels of 2007 blew previous records 'out of the water'!

In July 2007 over thirty houses in the village were directly affected by river flooding, with over six foot of water recorded in some properties. The damage done to properties (many of which are old timber framed cottages) was catastrophic. Residents endured a cold winter in caravans, one household lived in their caravan for over TWO YEARS, and another did not return until July 2010!

Residents formed UFAG in March 2008 with the aim of securing a permanent flood defence for the village - a lofty aim but with a determined committee! Space does not allow a detailed commentary of all the letters, emails, meetings, phone calls, newsletters, broken plates, wine consumption, grovelling and a murderous plot to bury at least two recalcitrant landowners. Suffice to say, that anyone who has ever been involved in keeping residents, councils and agencies 'on board' for over three years knows exactly what I mean!

No! It is not possible to raise the lane that high!.... "We need a flood gate" .... "I'm not having a flood defence on my land - I don't flood!".... Sorry, The EA are still undertaking a newt survey.... We are going to need more clay etc etc.,

The EA (supported by UFAG) successfully applied to the Severn Trent RFDC in 2009 for monies to construct a permanent flood bund - all was looking bright! We had to return cap in hand in July 2010 with a request for a further £750K, a pump was required and, yes, we were right about the floodgate! UFAG agreed to contribute £25K towards the shortfall and the RFDC gave us the money...phew! The Uckingham Flood Protection Defence was formerly opened in July 2011, christened with a bottle of de l'eau Sabrina (aka River Severn Water!) and the weather was, of course - WET!
