How to use the map

The main map shows country bus services operating in Herefordshire. A separate map shows Hereford city services. Schools, works and express services have been omitted from both maps for clarity. Details of bus times can be found in a set of three area timetable books, Hereford and Bromyard (Area 1), Leominster and Kington (Area 2), and Ross-on-Wye and Ledbury (Area 3), which are available, price 50p from bus stations, libraries and tourist information centres. Day travel tickets

"First Wyvern" tickets give unlimited travel on First buses throughout Herefordshire, Worcestershire and the West Midlands. Stagecoach "Explorer" tickets give unlimited travel on all Stagecoach services in Herefordshire and neighbouring counties. "Explorer" tickets can be purchased and used on all Stagecoach bus services. "Network Rider" tickets give unlimited travel on Stagecoach services X4 and 39, and all Cardiff Bus, Newport Transport and certain other operators' buses in Herefordshire and South Wales. In Herefordshire, they can be purchased on Stagecoach services X4 and 39.

On Sundays and Bank Holiday Mondays the "Sunday Rover" ticket can be used on all bus services in Herefordshire.

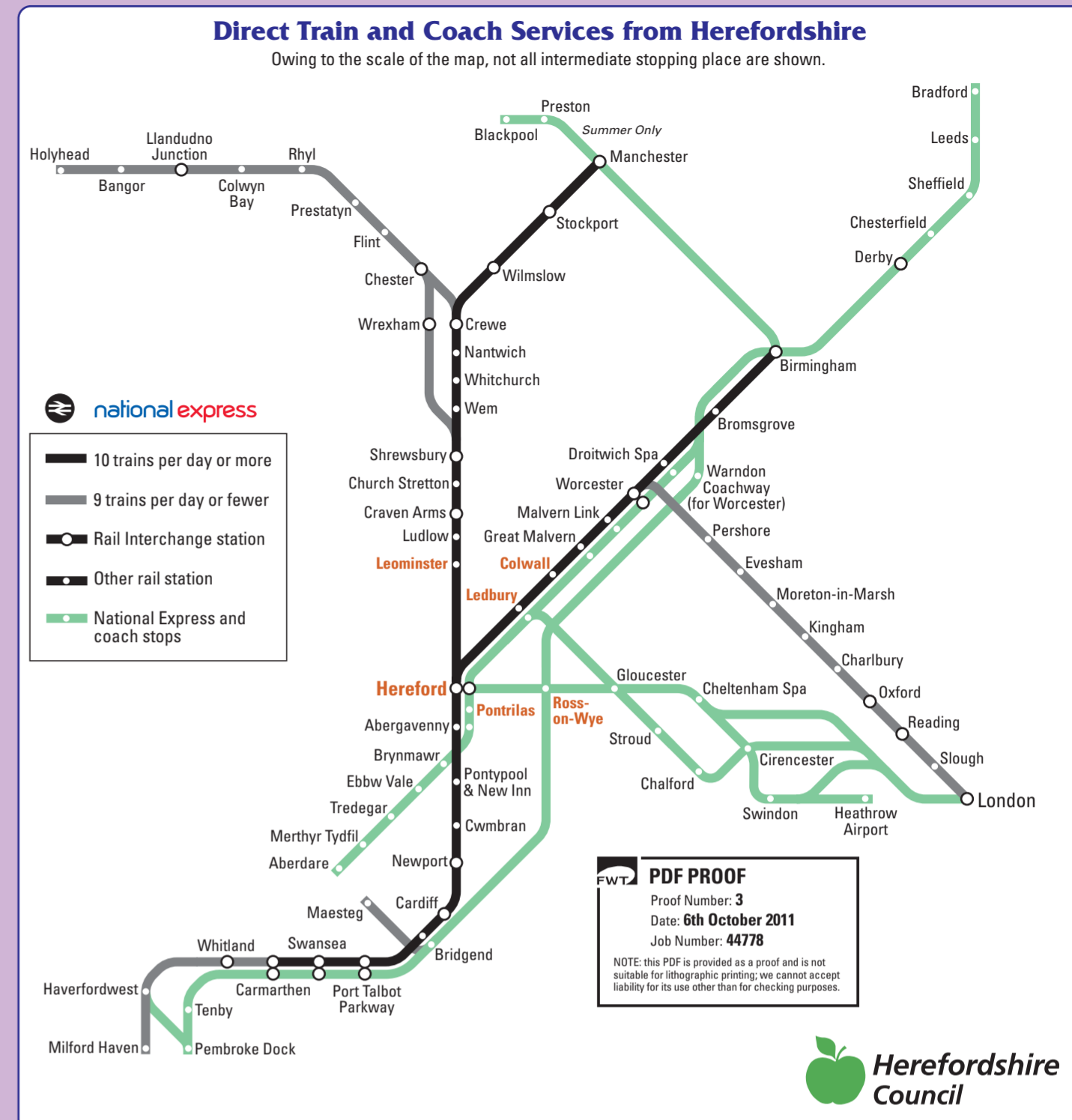

Frequency of Direct Trains from Hereford


