**THE HEREFORD CITY AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT AREA (NITROGEN DIOXIDE) ORDER
2001**

ORDER DESIGNATING AN AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT AREA

Whereas the County of Herefordshire District Council (“the Council”), having caused to be conducted a review and assessment of air quality in Herefordshire, is satisfied that the air quality objective in respect of the nitrogen dioxide annual mean specified in the Air Quality (England) Regulations 2000 is unlikely to be achieved in the area described in the schedule below by reason of projected exceedance of the objective.

The Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995 hereby makes the following order:

1. The area edged blue on the attached map which forms part of this Order and described in the schedule below is designated an Air Quality Management Area and shall be known as “The Hereford City Air Quality Management Area (Nitrogen Dioxide)”.
2. The Hereford City Air Quality Management Area (Nitrogen Dioxide) is an air quality management area in relation to nitrogen dioxide only.
3. This Order may be cited as “The Hereford City Air Quality Management (Nitrogen Dioxide) Order 2001”.
4. This Order shall come into force on 23rd November 2001 and shall remain in force until varied or revoked by subsequent order.

Schedule

The Hereford City Air Quality Management Area (Nitrogen Dioxide) incorporates that part of the A49 (T) corridor in Hereford City extending from Holmer Road in the north to Belmont Roundabout in the south also extending east along New Market/Blue School Street and west along Eign Street as far as Barton Yard junction, as more particularly delineated edged in blue on the map attached to this order.
