C1075 Woodseaves Road from a point 187 metres west of the junction of the C1075 with the A4111 for a distance of 352 metres in a westerly direction. U90622 Church Lane for its entire adopted length. U90623 Orchard Close for its entire adopted length. All relevant orders or parts thereof will be revoked on the coming into operation of this Order. This Order will come into operation on 31 August 2018. 


