PUBLIC NOTICE OF CONTINUATION

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1)

**HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL
PUBLIC FOOTPATH F80001 (PART) HEREFORD,
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2017**

NOTICE is hereby given that the County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, has made an Order under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), the effect of which is to temporarily close the following public right of way:

Public Footpath F80001 from OS Grid Reference SO 5107, 4001 to SO 5106, 3996 as shown on the plan.

The closure is required due to the danger caused by fire damaged buildings.

There are exemptions in the Order to permit pedestrian access (and/or vehicular access at the discretion of the statutory undertaker) to any land or premises having a frontage to the above said highway affected where there is no other form of access; and to any access allowing the necessary works to be undertaken.

The alternate route is via High Town, footpath F80002 and East Street and vice versa.

The Order came into force on 20 March 2015 and was due to expire after a period of six months but as works have not yet been completed the Secretary of State has consented to extend the closure by an additional period of 12 months.

The continuation of the Order, by the above said direction, will mean that the Temporary Closure Order due to expire on 20 September 2017 will continue in force until 20 September 2018 or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. Any further said extension will require the further consent of the Secretary of State.
