PUBLIC NOTICE OF CONTINUATION

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1)

**HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL
PUBLIC FOOTPATH MD25 (PART) MUCH DEWCHURCH,
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2016**

NOTICE is hereby given that the County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, has made an Order under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), the effect of which is to temporarily close the following public right of way:

Public Footpath MD25 from at OS Grid Reference SO 4472, 2861 as shown on the plan.

The Order for closure is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public caused by a damaged footbridge.

There are exemptions in the Order to permit pedestrian access (and/or vehicular access at the discretion of the statutory undertaker) to any land or premises having a frontage to the above said highway affected where there is no other form of access; and to any access allowing the necessary works to be undertaken.

The landowner has agreed a temporary permissive alternative route as shown on the plan.

The Order came into force on 7 July 2016 and was due to expire after a period of six months but as works have not yet been completed the Secretary of State has consented to extend the closure by an additional period of 12 months.

The continuation of the Order, by the above said direction, will mean that the Temporary Closure Order due to expire on 7 January 2018 will continue in force until 7 January 2019 or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. Any further said extension will require the further consent of the Secretary of State.
