The County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. The Order shall come into operation on 4^{-h}October 2019 and may be cited as "Herefordshire Council (A4110 Kingsland) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2019".
- 2. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 40 mph on the following length of road;

A4110 at Kingsland between a point 492 metres north west of its junction with the B4360 North Road and a point 95 metres north of its junction with the C1037 Hostel Lane.

- 5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.

Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the following Order which is in operation prior to the date mentioned in Article 1 of this Order will be revoked in its entirety from the date mentioned in the said Article 1:

30 miles per hour along the C1036 from its junction with the A4110, for a distance of 410 metres in an easterly direction and

40 miles per hour along the A4110 from a point 490 metres northwest of its junction with the B4360, for a distance of 1340 metres in a southerly direction.
