Location: Wellington Civic and Leisure Centre

Grant recipient: Telford and Wrekin Council

Purpose: A functional multi purpose civic building with a leisure centre, café area, library, offices, a registry office, swimming pool and leisure facilities.

Main lighting and public areas are currently lit by T5 luminaries, compact fluorescents (CFLs)



Energy efficiency measure: LED Lighting

LED Lighting — Light emitting diodes, also known as LED technologies, offer better working conditions through optimised luminaries, flexible lighting control and improved use of daylight.

822 lights replaced with LED equivalents

Predicted energy saving: 149,465 kWh **Anticipated cost saving =** £21,721yr **CO2 savings/yr:** 52.5t CO2/yr
