From a point seven metres south of its junction with the B4362 for a distance of 260 metres in a southerly direction.

- 3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 4. References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification substitution or re-enactment thereof.
