Various Roads Kingsland and Cobnash: To extend the 30mph at Kingsland on U93026 Chapel Lane and B4360 and to consolidate the existing 30mph speed limit Orders at Kingsland and to introduce a 40mph speed limit at Cobnash.

This Order shall come into operation on 12th July 2021.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS KINGSLAND AND COBNASH) (30MPH & 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

The County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 82 & 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (referred to as "the Act"), after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

1. The Order shall come into operation on 12th July 2021 and may be cited as

"HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS KINGSLAND AND COBNASH) (30MPH & 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021"


- 2. For the purposes of Section 82 of the said Act No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of **30mph** on the following stretches of road;
 - **B4360** From a point 81 metres south east of its junction with the U93026 Chapel Lane to a point 355 metres South East of its junction with the U93029 Hamlyn Place.
 - **C1036** From its junction with the B4360 to a point 290 metres east of its junction with the A4110.
 - C1039 From its junction with the B4360 to its junction with the U93022 Boarsfield.
 - U93024 Tudor Place From its junction with the B4360 for its entire length.
 - U93021 Church Lane From its junction with the B4360 for its entire length.
 - U93020 St Michaels Avenue From its junction with the B4360 for its entire length.
 - U93027 Orchard Close From its junction with the B4360 for its entire length.
 - U93029 Hamlyn Place From its junction with the B4360 for its entire length.
 - U93023 Lugg Green Road From its junction with the C1039 for its entire length.
 - U93022 Boarsfield From its junction with the C1039 for its entire length.
- 3. For the purposes of Section 84 of the said Act No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of **30mph** on the following stretches of road;
 - B4360 From its junction with the A4110 to a point 81 metres south east of its junction with the U93026 Chapel Lane.
 & From a point 528 metres north of its junction with the C1037 Hostel Lane to a point 355 metres South East of its junction with the U93029 Hamlyn Place.
 - **C1036** From its junction with the A4110 to a point 290 metres east of its junction with A4110.
 - **C1039** From its junction with the U93022 Boarsfield for a distance of 88 metres in a northerly direction.
 - U93025 Highfield Close From its junction with the B4360 for its entire length.

- **U93026 Chapel Lane** From its junction with the B4360 to its junction with the A4110.
- 4. For the purposes of Section 84 of the said Act No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of **40mph** on the following stretches of road;
 - **B4360** from a point 732 metres east of its junction with C1037 to a point 528 metres north of its junction with C1037.
 - **C1037** Hostel Lane from its junction with B4360 to a point 420 metres west of its junction with B4360.
- 5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 6. Any provisions contained in any previous speed limit orders in relation to the lengths of road subject to this Order which are in operation prior to the date mentioned in Article 1 of this Order will be revoked in their entirety from the date mentioned in Article 1 of this Order.
- 7. References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification substitution or re-enactment thereof.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING

The implementation of the proposed speed limit under section 82 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 is necessary for the following reasons:

- To ensure access and egress from developments along the section of road can be achieved by vehicles safely
- Ensure vehicle speeds are appropriate to the surrounding environment and to the physical nature of the road
- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- For preserving or improving the amenity of the area through which the road runs.

The Council reserves the right to produce an amended or further statement in the context of any public enquiry or judicial proceedings to these proposals.
