The deposit comprises this statement and the accompanying plan.

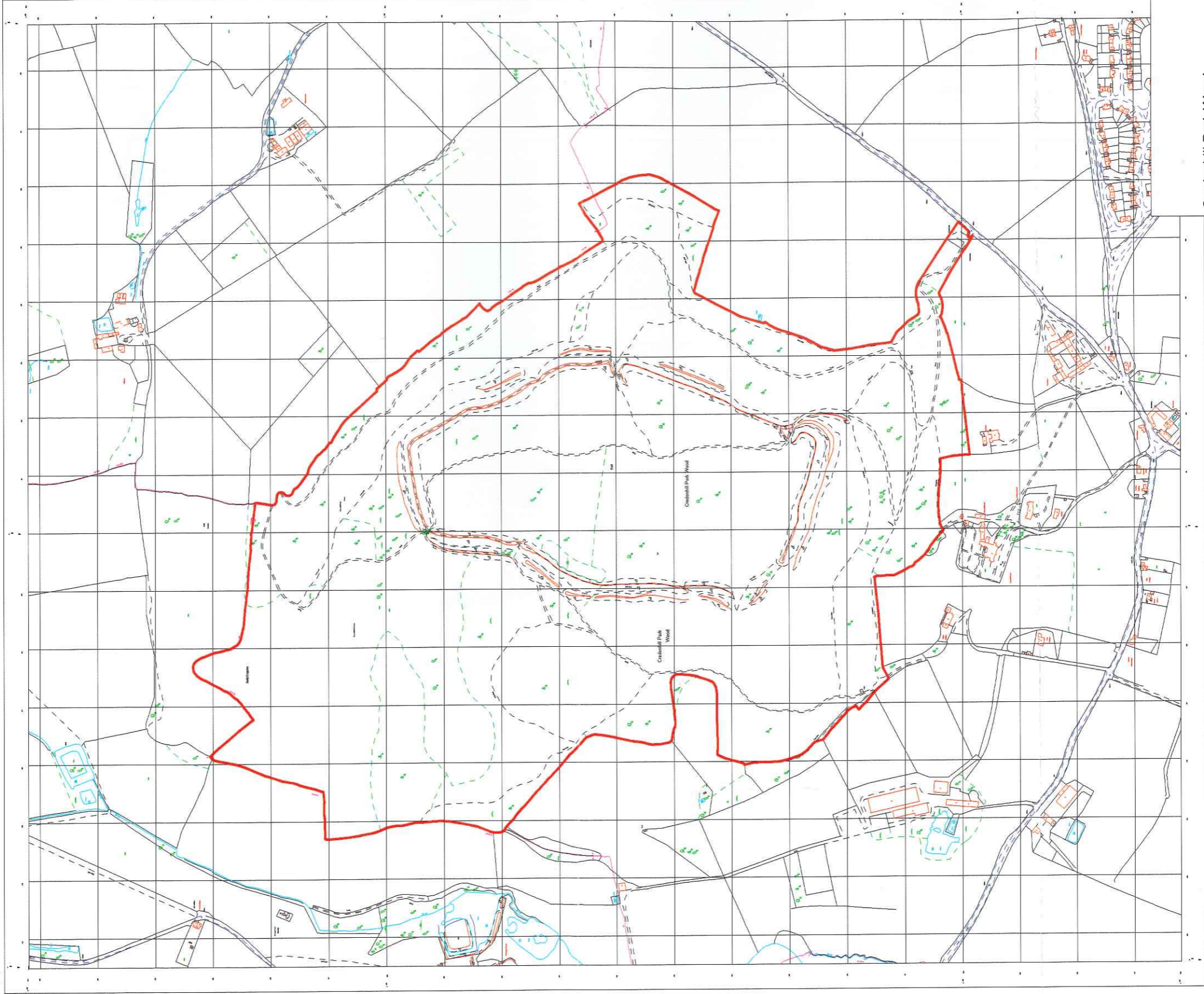

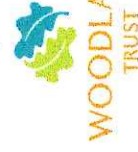

STATUTORY DECLARATION

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 31 (6)

I SARAH PRIESTMAN DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. The Woodland Trust, a company limited by guarantee and registered charity no. 294344, is and has been since 13<sup>th</sup> November 2002 the owner of the land known as Credenhill Park Wood, Credenhill, Herefordshire more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 29th of January 2003 the Woodland Trust deposited with County of Herefordshire District Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating our property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured purple on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths and no other ways had been dedicated as highways over our property.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 29<sup>th</sup> January 2003 referred to in 2 above other than those highways with footpaths marked in the appropriate colour on the plan accompanying this declaration and at the present time the Woodland Trust has no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over its property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2005 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
