## PUBLIC NOTICE OF CONTINUATION

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1)**

**HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL  
PUBLIC FOOTPATHS CW29 & CW29A (PART), COLWALL,  
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2017**

NOTICE is hereby given that the County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, has made an Order under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), the effect of which is to temporarily close the following public rights of way:

Public Footpaths CW29 & CW29A, from OS Grid Reference SO 7495, 4229 to 7513, 4214 and SO 7511, 4214 to 7504, 4205.

The Order for closure is required while construction of a new school is taking place.

There are exemptions in the Order to permit pedestrian access (and/or vehicular access at the discretion of the statutory undertaker) to any land or premises having a frontage to the above said highway affected where there is no other form of access; and to any access allowing the necessary works to be undertaken.

The alternate route is via CW29A, the C1166, CW30B, CW30 and the B4218.

The Order came into force on 1 November 2017 and was due to expire after a period of six months but as works have not yet been completed the Secretary of State has consented to extend the closure by an additional period of 12 months.

The continuation of the Order, by the above said direction, will mean that the Temporary Closure Order due to expire on 1 November 2017 will continue in force until 1 November 2018 or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. Any further said extension will require the further consent of the Secretary of State.
