

What is the St Owen St Cycle Contraflow Scheme?

The St Owen St Contraflow Cycleway would provide a direct link for cycles to access the city centre from the east. It will enable cycles to safely travel against the flow of the one way traffic on St Owen Street.

It will also provide pedestrian and parking improvements including;

- The installation of a signal controlled crossing at the junction of St Owen Street and Bath Street
- The introduction of footway build outs to improve the ease and safety of crossing of the carriageway at key points along St Owen Street.
- Changing the angled parking bays to parallel to improve the safer use of these bays by vehicles.

Objectives of the Scheme

The objectives of the scheme are:

- To provide a safe cycle route from the east of the city into the city centre.
- To improve the ease and safety for pedestrians crossing St Owen Street
- To improve the safety of vehicles using parking bays along St Owen Street.
