There were two themes of this event; PREVENT and LADO. Neville Meredith; Community Cohesion Officer, led the PREVENT theme, and Paul Rooney; Safeguarding & Review Manager, and Maia Whitelegg; QA manager, led the LADO theme.

Neville took us through what radicalisation means and how children might become vulnerable to it. He then led several workshop sessions relating to an iceberg analogy, push and pull factors, noticing that a child has become subject to radicalisation, and what an adult might do about it.

Paul took us through the LADO legislation and statutory guidance, the LADO criteria, the role of the LADO, and what happens when an allegation against an adult who works with children is made. He then led a workshop based on assessing whether a LADO referral should be made in several different circumstances, considering the LADO criteria.
