If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with that person may, within six weeks from the date the order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (U82100 THE OVAL, HEREFORD) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2017

The County of Herefordshire District Council, ("the Council"), in exercise of its powers under section 1, 2, and 3, and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act of 1984 (referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with part III of schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. The Order shall come into operation on 8th September 2017 and may be cited as "Herefordshire Council (U82100 The Oval, Hereford) (One-Way Traffic) Order 2017".
- 2. Interpretation:

In this Order -

'Motor vehicle' shall have the meaning as assigned to it in Section 136 of "the Act of 1984".

'Pedal Cycle' shall have the meaning as assigned to it in Schedule 1 of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.


- 3. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle or pedal cycle to proceed along the length of the U82100 The Oval, Hereford between its junction with Goodrich Grove and a point 236.5 metres north-east of the junction with Goodrich Grove and which for identification purposes only is shown on the attached plan in any direction other than north-east to south-west.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order applies to:
 - (a) A vehicle being used for fire and rescue, ambulance or police purposes
 - (b) Anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform
- 5. The County of Hereford and Worcester (Belmont Road Service Road, Hereford) (One- Way, Traffic) Order 1979 is hereby revoked.
- 6. References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification substitution or re-enactment thereof.


The Order is being made for the following reasons:

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

THE COUNTY OF HEREFORD AND WORCESTER

BELMONT ROAD SERVICE ROAD, HEREFORD)

(ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1979

The County Council of Hereford and Worcester, in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967"), and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the said Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

- No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that part of Belmont Road Service Road in the City of Hereford in the County of Hereford and Worcester from its junction with the Oval to its junction with Goodrich Grove in a direction other than from north-east to south-west.
- 2. This Order shall come into operation of the 19th day of February , 1979 and may be cited as the County of Hereford and Worcester (Belmont Road Service Road, Hereford) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1979.
- 3. The City of Hereford (Access Road to the Oval) (One-Way) Order 1964 is hereby revoked.
