# HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (C1166 MILL LANE, COLWALL) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that the County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, in exercise of its enabling powers has made the above named Order under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is as follows:

1. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along the following length of road:

## C1166, MILL LANE, COLWALL

From its junction with B4218 Walwyn Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 190 metres.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2017, together with a relevant plan, a copy of any orders to be revoked and Statement of Reasons for making the Order are available for inspection during normal office hours at the Council Offices, Plough Lane, Hereford HR4 0LE and at the Ledbury Customers Service Centre, The Masters House, St Katherine's, Ledbury, HR8 1EA. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

### HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (C1166, MILL LANE, COLWALL) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2017

The County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council in exercise of its powers under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act of 1984 (referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. The Order shall come into operation on *15<sup>th</sup>December 2017* and may be cited as "Herefordshire Council (C1166, Mill Lane, Colwall) (30 mph speed limit) Order 2017".
- 2. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along the following lengths of road:

### C1166, Mill Lane, Colwall

From a its junction with the B4218 Walwyn Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 190 metres

and as shown for identification purposes only on the attached plan.

- No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 4. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the following Order will be revoked in its entirety from the date mentioned in Article 1 hereto:

5. References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification substitution or re-enactment thereof.

#### (C1166, MILL LANE, COLWALL)

#### (RESTRICTED ROADS) (NO.6) ORDER 1992

Hereford and Worcester County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby direct as follows:-

- That length of C1166 Mill Lane in the Parish of Colwall in the District of Malvern Hills in the County of Hereford and Worcester which extends from its junction with B4218 Walwyn Road for a distance of 136 metres in a north westerly direction shall become a restricted road for the purpose of Section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984;
- This Order may be cited as The County of Hereford and Worcester (C1166, Mill Lane, Colwall) (Restricted Roads) (No.6) Order 1992 and shall come into operation on the 27th day of July 1992.
