Sam,

I can confirm we have a scheme at Luston and Yarpole WwTW to meet the requirements of the Water Framework Directive (WFD) for 'no deterioration for ammonia' as part of our AMP6 Capital Investment Programme (2015-2020). The new permit will come into force on the 31st of March 2018.

The works are currently progressing on site, and when complete will be able to meet all the environmental requirements in the permit.

Further to this, the development growth proposed in the Neighbourhood Plans of both Luston Group Parish and Yarpole Group Parish will be able to be accommodated.

With regard to Policy YG13 of the NDP, our preference would be for the Policy to remain owing to the length of the Plan Period (to 2031) and the potential for development growth over and above the proposed numbers (e.g. if there is no five year housing land supply, potential for more windfall/speculative developments). We do acknowledge that the wording of both the policy and supporting text could be slightly amended, so if the Inspector would like us to make any suggestions please let me know.

Following on from my previous email about the letter from Welsh Water confirming that the works to the Luston SWT will be complete in March this year, I am concerned about the response given by the YGPC to my Question 20. I feel that Welsh Water should be given an opportunity to comment on what is a somewhat technical response. Are they able to confirm that once completed the works will then meet all of the relevant environmental requirements? Obviously, a quick response is highly desirable.

For ease of reference my question and the YGPC response is set out below.

Q20. Welsh Water have confirmed that works to increase the capacity of the Lucton and Yarpole Treatment works are programmed for 2018. In view of this, does Policy YG13 have any continued purpose? If so, would the YGPC please provide an updated wording for policy and text.

There remain concerns that measures set out in the Nutrient Management Plan have still to be developed to the extent that the River Lugg Sub-Catchment may not meet the requirements of the Habitats Directive. Although the works may commence in 2018, the evidence base to the Nutrient Management Plan indicates that in theory Best Available Technology should be able to address the phosphate tripping requirements although there is an acknowledgement that it may be harder for this to be done for small WwTWs. Hence the measures/theory proposed may not work or be delayed. It is felt that a precautionary approach is still required as set out in this policy. As it stands if the policy is changed the references to it within the SEA may become negative.

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
