We note the reference within paragraph 6.22 (relating to Policy TS6) to a potential negative effect for a Grade II heritage asset, identified within the SA. Setting impacts are not only limited to visual setting issues (See Good Practice Advice Note 3: The Setting of Heritage Assets on Historic England's website) and it is possible that harm could arise, even where there is no visual connection between a development site and a heritage asset. We would require sight of the heritage assessment for this site, in order to make a judgement as to whether we consider that harm is likely or what mitigation measures could be appropriate. We note the potential landscaping measure identified but are not clear how relevant this is if there is no visibility between the development site and the heritage asset? Are other mitigation measures more appropriate?

Paragraph 6.27 identifies that there are designated heritage assets, of the highest importance, that could be effected by the proposed development. We would require more information on how this development could impact on the setting of these heritage assets and what mitigation measures may therefore be appropriate. It may be that design considerations should be included within the Plan, to ensure that any potential harm can be overcome, when any future planning applications are received by the Council.
