The effect of the Order is to introduce a 30 mph speed limit in Pomona Grove and extend the existing 30 mph speed limit along the B4221 and also confirm the existing 30 mph and 40 mph speed limit restrictions in the following roads in Crow Hill:

30 mph Limit: The B4221, from a point 553 metres south-west of its junction with the B4224 Hereford to Mitcheldean Road in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 892 metres. The B4224 from a point 310 metres south of its junction with the B4221 Ross-On-Wye to Newent Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 631 metres. The U70018 Powell Croft for its entire length; the U70019 The Pastures for its entire length, the U70022 Pomona Grove for its entire length and the U70021 Spring Meadow for its entire length.

40mph Limit: The B4224 from a point 321 metres north of its junction with the B4221, Ross- On-Wye to Newent Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 407 metres. The Order shall come into operation on 11th May 2018.

3. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along the following length of road:

B4224, Hereford to Mitcheldean Road

From a point 321 metres north of its junction with the B4221 Ross-On-Wye to Newent Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 407 metres.

- No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 5. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the following Orders will be revoked in their entirety from the date mentioned in Article 1 hereto:
- The County of Hereford and Worcester (Restricted Roads) (No.15) Order 1981 and The County of Herefordshire District Council (B4221, Upton Bishop) (30mph Speed Limit) (Variation) Order 2000.
- 6. References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification substitution or re-enactment thereof.




