THE COUNTY OF HEREFORDSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL (A480 CREDENHILL HEREFORD) (30 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that the County of Herefordshire District Council ("Herefordshire Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, made the above Order on 21st June 2018, the effect of which is as follows:

1. To reduce the speed limit on the following length of road from 40mph to 30mph:

A480 (Credenhill): from 88m south-east of the junction with the C1103 south-eastwards to 207m north of U73016 (The Priory Road, known as "Priory Lane").

(Please note that the effect of the order is to remove the 40mph limit, so that a 30mph limit applies by virtue of the system of streetlighting for this length of the A480).

The Order will come into operation on 6th July 2018.
