## These Orders will come into operation on 27 July 2018.







# HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (A4103, ROMAN ROAD, HEREFORD) (30 MPH RESTRICTED ROAD SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2018 AND HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (A4103, ROMAN ROAD, HEREFORD) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2018

The implementation of the speed limit under Sections 82(2)(b), 83(2) and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 is necessary for the following reasons:






