No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 mph along the **U71200 Old Ross Road** from a point 269 metres north east of its junction with the C1250 Llangrove Road in a north-easterly direction to its junction with the A4137, **C1251** from a point 137 metres northeast of the junction with U71234 Sandyway Lane in a south-westerly direction to a point 90 metres southwest of the junction with the U71232 Talybont Lane; **U71232 Talybont Lane** from its junction with the C1251 for a distance of 44 metres in a north-westerly direction; **U71232 Sandyway Lane** from its southernmost junction with the C1251 for a distance of 77 metres in a south-easterly direction and for the entire adopted lengths of the **U71233 Well Vale Lane**, **and U71239 Stoney Hill Industrial Estate**

The County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2)(a) and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 23 November 2018 and may be cited as "Herefordshire Council (Various Roads, Whitchurch) (30 mph and 40 mph speed limit) Order 2018".
- 2. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along the following lengths of road:

C1250 Llangrove Road

From its junction with the B4164 in a north-westerly direction to a point 50 metres north west of its junction with the U71243 Ridgeway Crescent.

U71243 Ridgeway Crescent

From its junction with the C1250 Llangrove Road for its entire adopted length.

U71244 Norton Close

From its junction with the U71236 for its entire adopted length.

U71236

From its junction with the C1250 Llangrove Road in a south-westerly direction to a point 154 metres southwest of the junction with the U71244 Norton Close.

U71200 Old Ross Road

From its junction with the C1250 Llangrove Road in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 269 metres.

B4164

From a point 4 metres east of where the centre lines of the C1250 and B4164 intersect and also from a point 16 metres south east of its junction with the southwest bound carriageway of the A40 and also from its junction with the U71236 to its junction with the C1257.

C1257

From its junction with the B4164 for its entire adopted length.

3. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 mph along the following lengths of road:

U71200 Old Ross Road

From a point 269 metres north east of its junction with the C1250 Llangrove Road in a north-easterly direction to its junction with the A4137.

from a point 137 metres northeast of the junction with U71234 Sandyway Lane in a south-westerly direction to a point 90 metres southwest of the junction with the U71232 Talybont Lane.

U71233 Well Vale Lane

For its entire length between its two junctions with the C1251.

U71239 Stoney Hill Industrial Estate

From its junction with the C1251 for its entire length.

U71232 Talybont Lane

From its junction with the C1251 for a distance of 44 metres in a north-westerly direction.

U71232 Sandyway Lane

From its southernmost junction with the C1251 for a distance of 77 metres in a south-easterly direction.

- 4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.

Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, in exercise of its powers under Section 82 (2) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the following Orders will be revoked in their entirety from the date mentioned in Article 1 hereto:






