DECISION	

On 14 November 2018, the monitoring officer considered a complaint alleging that Councillor G Fielding may have acted in breach of the code of conduct for members. The appointed independent person was consulted in considering the matter.

The monitoring officer and the independent person concluded that Councillor Fielding did breach the code of conduct. The reasons for this are:

- The complainant was a parish councillor for Cradley Parish Council and directly attributes their resignation to the behaviour of Councillor Fielding. A former clerk to the parish council who also attributed his behaviour to their resignation
- Councillor Fielding has on occasion demonstrated domineering, aggressive and confrontational behaviour. Although clearly an enthusiastic councillor from a local parish councillor, the manner in which he has conducted himself has at times caused others to feel intimidated.

The recommendation to Cradley Parish Council is that Councillor G Fielding receives training from the monitoring officer.

Relevant sections of the Cradley Parish Council Code of Conduct considered were:

VI. Rules of Conduct

- 11. Members shall in particular observe the following rules when acting as a Member or coopted Member of the Authority and Members are informed that you:
- (a) Do treat others with respect and courtesy.
- (c) Do not bully any person;
- (j) Do not conduct yourself in a manner which could reasonably be regarded as bringing your office or authority into disrepute.
