Q1. Do you agree that this (Oakfield Nash Lane) could be a suitable site for up to 4 additional residential traveller pitches?

Q1a. If no, please explain:
The proposed site is unsuitable for additional traveller pitches for several reasons. The access from Nash End Lane is difficult and can be dangerous, with restricted visibility on a blind summit. Nash End Lane already has large farm vehicles using it to access their land and is a bridleway. An increase in the volume of vehicles using the lane will be hazardous to residents and users, in particular large vehicles with trailers. The site will be visible from the lane. This parish has provision for travellers and an increase will put strain on already stretched resources. An increase in the number of itinerant people in the parish is already planned by Buchanan Trust, who provide a very valuable service to veterans, this further increase will upset the balance of a small community of residents, with no planned improvement in infrastructure - transport, shops, schools, doctors.
