

The Commons Act 2006 Section 22: Schedule 2, paragraph 2 (to register land as common land)

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by The Open Spaces Society to The County of Herefordshire District Council as Commons Registration Authority, concerning land adjacent to Adleymoor Common described more fully below.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows:

The land was not at any time finally registered as common land or as a town or village green under the 1965 Act; the land is otherwise recognised or designated as common land by or under an enactment; and is land to which this section applies.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by registering the land in the register of common land.

Description of the land concerned:

Approximately 3.035 hectares of land adjacent to Adleymoor Common in the parishes of Buckton and Croxall and Leintwardine. Situated between Ordnance Survey grid references: 338410 274728 and 338689 274709, as coloured red on the accompanying plan.
