The alternative route is via footpath BE1 or BE38.

The Order comes into force on 26 April 2019 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding six months from the said above date of operation (unless extended upon the direction of the Secretary of State) or until any said works which it is proposed to be carried out have been completed, (whichever is the earlier), or until determined by the Herefordshire Council.
