Declaration

I / We undertake to meet costs of the Herefordshire Council (or of BBLP working on its behalf) incurred in making this application I /we understand this is estimated to be £3,000 to cover the costs of processing the application, legal costs, advertising and court fees. I / we further understand that additional costs may be incurred if objections are encountered.

I / We enclose a cheque for £750 (made payable to "Balfour Beatty Living Places") as initial part payment and understand that this is non-refundable. In addition I / we undertake to forward the remaining balance within 7 days of a written request from Herefordshire Council or its above said agents, and understand this is non-refundable should the required stopping up application to the Magistrates court be unsuccessful.

I / We undertake to meet the costs involved in any relocation of statutory undertakers' plant, together with the statutory undertakers' incidental expenses and to give Herefordshire Council or its said agents, such security as it may require (e.g. by way of a bond) for such costs, within such time period as they may request.

I / We undertake within such time period as requested to enter into any wayleave agreements required by any statutory undertakers for their apparatus which may be found to be located in the highway proposed to be stopped-up, if an undertaker wishes for such apparatus to remain in situ. I / We also agree to pay any such costs of the said undertaker, and any mortgagee / chargee of our property in this regard, in the time period requested by Herefordshire Council, which it is noted could be prior to the hearing date of the Stopping-up Order.
