PUBLIC NOTICE OF CONTINUATION

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1)

**HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL
PUBLIC FOOTPATH LX26, LX22 & LX22A, (PART) LEINTWARDINE,
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2019**

NOTICE is hereby given that the County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, has made an Order under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), the effect of which is to temporarily close the following public right of way:

Public Footpaths LX26, LX22 & LX22A, Leintwardine from OS Grid References SO 4353 7715 to 4329 7622; SO 4263 7695 to 4355 7664 & SO 4355 7664 to 4466 7645.

The Order for closure is required as the surface of the paths has been undermined, which may endanger footpath users.

There are exemptions in the Order to permit pedestrian access (and/or vehicular access at the discretion of the statutory undertaker) to any land or premises having a frontage to the above said highway affected where there is no other form of access; and to any access allowing the necessary works to be undertaken.

There is no alternative route.

The Order came into force on 19 August 2019 and was due to expire after a period of six months but as works have not yet been completed the Secretary of State has consented to extend the closure by an additional period of 12 months.

The continuation of the Order, by the above said direction, will mean that the Temporary Closure Order due to expire on 19 February 2022 will continue in force until 19 February 2023 or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. Any further said extension will require the further consent of the Secretary of State.
