(A4112, C1049, U94213, U94222 and U94223, KIMBOLTON) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2014

Notice is hereby given that The County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council in exercise of its enabling powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has made the above-named Speed Limit Order, the effect of which will be as follows:

1. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along the following lengths of roads:

A4112 from a point 54 metres west of the centreline of its junction with the U94222 Chestnut Avenue for a distance of 1364 metres, to a point 180 metres east of its junction with the centreline of the U94216 Church Hill;

C1049 from its junction with the A4112 for a distance of 135 metres in a northerly direction;

U94222 Chestnut Avenue from its junction with the A4112 for its entire length;

U94223 Stockton Rock from its junction with the C1049 for its entire length;

U94213 Hamnish Road from its junction with the A4112 for a distance of 196 metres in a southerly direction;

The above Orders will come into operation on 28th April 2014.

The existing Speed Limit Order, The County of Hereford and Worcester (A4112, Leominster to Tenbury Road, Kimbolton)(40 M.P.H Speed Limit) (No.2) Order 1992 shall be revoked on implementation of the above said provisions.

The County of Herefordshire District Council ("known as Herefordshire Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Herefordshire Council (A4112, C1049, U94213, U94222 and U94223, Kimbolton) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2014 and shall come into operation on the 12th day of May 2014.
- 2. No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along the following lengths of road:

The A4112 from a point 54 metres west of the centreline of its junction with the U94222 Chestnut Avenue for a distance of 1364 metres, to a point 180 metres east of its junction with the centreline of the U94216 Church Hill;

C1049 from its junction with the A4112 for a distance of 135 metres in a northerly direction;

U94222 Chestnut Avenue from its junction with the A4112 for its entire length;

U94223 Stockton Rock from its junction with the C1049 for its entire length;

U94213 Hamnish Road from its junction with the A4112 for a distance of 196 metres in a southerly direction;

and as shown for identification purposes only on the attached plan.

- 3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 5. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the following Order will be revoked in its entirety from the date mentioned in Article 1 hereto:

The County of Hereford and Worcester (A4112, Leominster to Tenbury Road, Kimbolton) (40 M.P.H Speed Limit) (No.2) Order 1992.

6. Reference to any statutory provisions herein shall include reference to any statutory modification or reenactment thereof.



Hereford and Worcester County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport under Part II of that Schedule hereby order as follows:-

- 1. The County of Hereford and Worcester (40 MPH Speed Limit)(No.1) Order 1982 is hereby revoked.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on that length of A4112, Leominster to Tenbury Road in the Parish of Kimbolton in the District of Leominster in the County of Hereford and Worcester which extends from a point 175 metres east of its junction with Church Hill for a distance of 1364 metres in a south westerly direction.
- 3. This Order may be cited as The County of Hereford and Worcester (A4112, Leominster to Tenbury Road, Kimbolton)(40 M.P.H Speed Limit) (No.2) Order 1992 and shall come into operation on the 16th day of March 1992


