

(U71224, LLANGROVE) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2015 the effect of which will be: U71224 – Northern Kerb line From a point 8 metres east of the centre line of the U71225 for a distance of 14 metres in an easterly direction. From a point 5.5 metres west of the centre line of the U71225 for a distance of 50 metres in a westerly direction. Southern Kerb line. From a point 15 metres east of the centreline of U71225 for a distance of 70 metres in a westerly direction.

(VARIOUS ROADS, BROMYARD)(WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2015 No waiting at any time -B4214 Panniers Lane - On the east side, from a point 63.5 metres north east of junction with C1110 Pencombe Lane for a distance of 34 metres in a north easterly direction. U65443 Butterfield (Buttsfield) On both sides, from the junction with B4203 New Road for a distance of 8 metres in a south east direction. B4203 New Road - South east side, from the junction with U65443 Butterfield (Buttsfield) for a distance of 10 metres in a north easterly direction. From the junction with U65443 Butterfield (Buttsfield) for a distance of 10 metres in a south westerly direction. From the junction with U65411 Little Hereford Street for a distance of 10 metres in a south westerly direction. From the junction U65411 Little Hereford Street for a distance of 5 metres in a north easterly direction. North west side, from a point 47.7 metres south west of the junction with the B4203 High Street for a distance of 22.3 metres in a south westerly direction. U65411 Little Hereford Street - On both sides, from the junction with B4203 New Road for a distance of 3.5 metres in a south easterly direction. U65405 Tower Hill. # (U71224, LLANGROVE) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2015

The County of Herefordshire District Council ("known as Herefordshire Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (referred to as "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

### Citation

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 26<sup>th</sup> February 2015 and may be cited as the Herefordshire Council (U71224, Llangrove) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2014.
- 2. (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-
  - "Disabled Permit Holders" means a person who has been issued with a valid Disabled Person Badge;
  - "Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000;
  - "Disabled Person's Vehicle" means a vehicle displaying a Disabled Persons Badge and Parking Disc.
  - "Driver", in relation to a vehicle waiting in a Parking Place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the Parking Place.
  - "Parking Disc" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000.
  - "Civil Enforcement Officer" means a person appointed in accordance with the provisions of Section 76 Traffic Management Act 2004
  - (2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying
    - (a) a Disabled Person's Badge in the relevant position, when:-
      - (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited thereon so that the front of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle; and
      - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the front of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle.
    - (b) a Parking Disc in the relevant position, when:-
      - (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the disc is exhibited thereon so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle: and

- (ii) in the case of a vehicle not so fitted, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the front of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer or Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait, load or unload at any time on those lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order and which for the purposes of identification only are shown on the attached plan.

## **Exemptions**

- 4. Where referred to in this Order nothing shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of those lengths of road referred to in the Schedule and relevant Articles hereto so long as may be necessary where:
  - a) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as is necessary to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle;
  - the vehicle is used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes or a vehicle (other than a Passenger Vehicle) in the service of a local authority is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - c) the vehicle is in the service of or employed by the Post Office Company, or similar service vehicle, and is waiting while postal packets are being unloaded from the vehicle, or having been unloaded there from, are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected or is in use in connection with the servicing of telephone kiosks in the said lengths of roads;
  - d) the vehicle, not being a Passenger Vehicle, is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable it to be used for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any said lengths of road or the laying erection, alteration, removal or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telegraphic line or traffic sign in any said lengths of road;
  - e) the vehicle not being a Passenger Vehicle is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;

### Miscellaneous

4. References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification substitution or re-enactment thereof.

**U71224 – Southern Kerb line.** From a point 15 metres east of the centreline of U71225 for a distance of 70 metres in a westerly direction.
