Notice is hereby given that the County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, in exercise of its enabling powers under sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to make the above-named orders the effect of which will be the following:

- 1. That no person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along the lengths of road specified below; and
- 2. No vehicle shall be permitted to overtake any other moving motor vehicle along the lengths of road specified below
- **B4214** from a point 366m south east of its junction with U65035 The Crest to a point 195m north west of this junction in both directions
- **U65035 The Crest** to the limit of its adoption in both directions

**B4214** from a point 366m south east of its junction with U65035 The Crest to a point 195m north west of this junction

U65035 The Crest to the limit of its adoption

- 3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 4. The following order is to be revoked;



- This Order shall come into operation on the ...day of 2020 and may be cited as "HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (B4214 EDWYN RALPH) (PROHIBITION OF OVERTAKING) ORDER 2020"
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of or permission from a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to overtake any other moving motor vehicle on the lengths of road specified below:
  - **B4214** from a point 366m south east of its junction with U65035 The Crest to a point 195m north west of this junction in both directions
  - **U65035 The Crest** to the limit of its adoption in both directions
- 3. The restrictions imposed by Article 2 of this Order shall not apply to the following vehicles:
  - a) Emergency service vehicles (Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance) when on an emergency call
- 4. References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof.
