Notice is hereby given that the County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, in exercise of its enabling powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to make the above-named order the effect of which will be:

That no person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph along the following lengths of road; **A4110** from a point 300 meters north-east of its junction with C1035 to its junction with B4529.

A4110 from its junction with B4529 and C1035 for a distance of 128 meters in a south-westerly direction.

C1035 from its junction with A4110 for a distance of 145 meters in a south-westerly direction.

C1035 from its junction with A4110 and B4529 for a distance of 270 meters in a westerly direction.

B4529 from its junction with A4110 and C1035 for a distance of 248 meters in a north-easterly direction

ORDER 2021

The County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act of 1984 (referred to as "the Act"), after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

The Order shall come into operation on [DATE] and may be cited as (VARIOUS ROADS, SHIRL HEATH AND LAWTON CROSS CROSSROADS) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021".

For the purposes of Section 84 of the said Act - No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 40mph on the following stretches of road;

A4110 from a point 300 meters north-east of its junction with C1035 to its junction with B4529.

A4110 from its junction with B4529 and C1035 for a distance of 128 meters in a southwesterly direction.

C1035 from its junction with A4110 for a distance of 145 meters in a south-westerly direction.

C1035 from its junction with A4110 and B4529 for a distance of 270 meters in a westerly direction.

B4529 from its junction with A4110 and C1035 for a distance of 248 meters in a northeasterly direction

No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.

References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification substitution or re-enactment thereof.
