How to reserve items on the library catalogue

Reservations can be placed on any item on the Herefordshire Libraries catalogue. You can reserve titles free of charge, and when they are available they will be delivered to your local library for you to collect.

Step 1 Log in to your account

Go to https://prism.librarymanagementcloud.co.uk/herefordshire/ and sign into 'My account' with your library account number and PIN.



You can find your account number on the back of your library card (include an 'X' if this appears as the last character) or in the email we sent if you joined the library online.

If you don't know your PIN, you can reset it here.

Step 2 Search for items

Search for items using keywords from author and/or title in the box labelled 'Search the library catalogue'. Enter one or more keywords and click on 'Search'. For more tips on how to search for items see 'Help'.



Step 3 Reserve items
