Notice is hereby given that the County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, in exercise of its enabling powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has made the above-named order the effect of which will be the following:

That no person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour along the following lengths of road:

A44 from a point 103 metres southwest of the junction with the C1059 to a point 783 metres east of its junction with the U94210

That no person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along the following lengths of road:

C1059 from its junction with the A44 to a point 390 metres northeast of this junction

That no person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along the following lengths of road:

U94030 Humber Close for its entire adopted length

This Order will come into operation on 26 February 2021.


The County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act of 1984 (referred to as "the Act"), after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers makes the following titled Order.


- The Order shall come into operation on 26 February 2021 and may be cited as HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (A44, C1059 & U94030) (50MPH, 40MPH AND 30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021
- 2. For the purposes of Section 84 of the said Act:
 - (a) No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of **50mph** on the following stretches of road;
 - A44 from a point 103 metres southwest of the junction with the C1059 to a point 783 metres east of its junction with the U94210
 - (b) No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of **40mph** on the following stretches of road;
 - C1059 from its junction with the A44 to a point 390 metres northeast of this junction
 - (c) No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 30mph on the following stretches of road;
 - U94030 Humber Close for its entire adopted length
- 3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 4. The following Orders are to be revoked:
 - HEREFORD AND WORCESTER (A44, LEOMINSTER TO BROMYARD ROAD, DOCKLOW) (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (NO.7) ORDER 1993
 - THE COUNTY OF HEREFORDSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL (A44 AND U94030 STEENS BRIDGE) (50MPH AND 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2005
- 5. References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification substitution or re-enactment thereof.

HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (A44, C1059 & U94030) (50MPH, 40MPH AND 30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

Hereford and Worcester County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby order as follows:-

- No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on A44 Leominster to Bromyard Road in the Parish of Docklow in the District of Leominster in the County of Hereford and Worcester from a point 30 metres west of its junction with UC94008 Buckland Road to a point 445 metres east of its junction with UC94210 Lower Docklow Church Road.
- This Order may be cited as The County of Hereford and Worcester (A44 Leominster to Bromyard Road, Docklow) (50 M.P.H Speed Limit) (No. 7) Order 1993 and shall come into operation on the 10th day of January 1994

 - Thirty miles per hour along the U94030 Humber Close from its junction with the A44 in a southerly direction for its whole length;
