#### **ORDER 2021**

Notice is hereby given that the County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, in exercise of its enabling powers under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to make the above-named Order the effect of which will be the following:

That no person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along the following lengths of road:

#### <u>A4112</u>

From a point 406m northeast of its junction with C1052 to a point 1010m southwest of this junction C1052

From its junction with A4112 to a point 164m southeast of this junction From its junction with A4112 to a point 80m northwest of this junction The current 40mph Speed Limit will be revoked in full.

Due to the difficulty for local authorities to make documents relating to Proposed Traffic Regulation Orders available for public inspection in their offices during the coronavirus pandemic, **The Traffic Orders Procedure (Coronavirus) (Amendment) (England) Regulations 2020,** (which came into force on 23 May 2020) have been introduced to enable local authorities to put alternative arrangements in place to make documents available to the public. ## HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (A4112 & C1052, LEYSTERS) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

The County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (referred to as "the Act"), after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

The Order shall come into operation on [DATE] and may be cited as

(A4112 & C1052, LEYSTERS) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021".

For the purposes of Section 84 of the said Act - No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of **30mph** on the following stretches of road;

**A4112** from a point 406m northeast of its junction with C1052 to a point 1010m southwest of this junction

C1052 from its junction with A4112 to a point 164m southeast of this junction

C1052 from its junction with A4112 to a point 80m northwest of this junction

3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.

4. In accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act, any previous Speed Limit Orders relating to the lengths of road referred to in this Order are hereby revoked on the coming into operation of this Order.

5. References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification substitution or re-enactment thereof.

# HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (A4112 & C1052, LEYSTERS) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

The implementation of the proposed Speed Limit under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 is necessary for the following reasons:

For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising

To allow Leysters to have a 30mph 'village speed limit' in accordance with Department for Transport guidance documents "village speed limits" and "setting local speed limits"
