Notice is hereby given that the County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, in exercise of its enabling powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has made the above-named order the effect of which will be the following:

That no person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along the following length of road:

A438 from a point 82 metres west of its junction with U66205 (Little Tarrington Common Road) to a point 412 metres southeast of its junction with U66205.

This Order will shall come into operation on 30 April 2021

2. For the purposes of Section 84 of the said Act - No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of **40mph** on the following stretches of road;

A438 from a point 82 meters west of its junction with U66205 (Little Tarrington Common Road) to a point 412 meters southeast of its junction with U66205.

- 4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 5. References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification substitution or re-enactment thereof.


