Separate your recycling from your rubbish and put your black sacks/clear recycling sacks out on your collection day.



Remember, recycling is collected one week and rubbish the next. If you don't have a black bin, you can put out up to 4 black sacks on general rubbish week. Extra rubbish will not be collected.

Reducing rubbish and increasing recycling

The average rubbish bin in Herefordshire is made up of the following*:



*1.4% of the contents was glass. If you have a recycling sack service instead of a bin, please take your glass to a household recycling centre or bring bank.

8.6% of the rubbish thrown out in Herefordshire could be recycled using the green bin or clear recycling sacks* Check the next page to make sure you are recycling everything you can.

household metal packaging

mixed paper & card

- ✓ Newspapers/magazines
- ✓ Phone directories
- ✓ Catalogues/brochures
- ✓ Junk mail/leaflets
- Letters
- ✓ Greetings cards
- Envelopes
- Thin cardboard boxes eg.cereal boxes, ready meal boxes
- Corrugated/thick cardboard boxes
- ✓ Egg boxes
- ✓ Kitchen/toilet roll tubes

Please remember...

- Rinse out all food and drink containers
- Make sure your recycling items are dry
- Don't recycle cardboard that has food residues on it
- Place items loose into your sacks – please don't put them into carrier bags



household plastic packaging

- ✓ Detergent/fabric conditioner bottles
- \checkmark Toiletry bottles
- ✓ Yoghurt/cream/custard pots

mixed glass bottles & jars
