To extend the 40mph speed limit at Bailey Lane End on C1277 northwards and to consolidate the remainder of the restriction into one new Order. The sections of road effected are:

C1277 from a point 105 meters south of its junction with the U70211, to a point 513 meters north of its junction with the U70211.

U70211 from its junction with the C1277, for a distance of 280 meters in a north-westerly direction This Order shall come into operation on 28th June 2021.

The County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (referred to as "the Act"), after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

1. The Order shall come into operation on **28 th June** 2021 and may be cited as

"HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (C1277 & U70211 – BAILEY LANE END) (40 M.P.H SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

- 2. For the purposes of Section 84 of the said Act No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of **40mph** on the following stretches of road;
 - **C1277** from a point 105 meters south of its junction with the U70211, to a point 513 meters north of its junction with the U70211.
 - **U70211** from its junction with the C1277, for a distance of 280 meters in a north-westerly direction
- 3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 4. In accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act, any previous Speed Limit Orders relating to the lengths of road referred to in this Order are hereby revoked on the coming into operation of this Order.
- 5. References to any statutory provision herein shall include reference to any statutory modification substitution or re-enactment thereof.

The County of Herefordshire District Council ("the Council"), in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. That no person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along the lengths of roads as follows;
 - The C1277 at Bailey Lane End, from a point 105 metres south of its junction with the U70211, to a point 237 metres north of that junction
 - The U70211 at Bailey Lane End, from its junction with the C1277, for a distance of 280 metres in a north westerly direction

and as shown for identification purposes only on the attached plan.

2. Reference to any statutory provisions herein shall include reference to any statutory modification, substitution or re-enactment thereof.

This Order may be cited as The County of Herefordshire District Council (C1277 & U70211 at Bailey Lane End) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2009 and shall come into operation on the 8th May 2009.
