### Herefordshire Figures (3 years April 2018 – March 2021)

- Rescue or Evacuation From Water Incidents = 171
  - Involving Vehicles = 115
- Flooding Incidents = 266
  - Involving Vehicles = 41
- Flooding Incidents with Evacuations =71



#### Prevent

- Divert known 'run off' banks, walls, sand bagging
- Keep your ditches/culverts/grips clear
- Expectation/Reliance?
  - Sandbags
  - Emergency Services priority is LIFE; specialist resources.
  - Encourage community/personal resilience





### **Protect and Prepare**

- Install property flood resilience (PFR) measures
  - door/airbrick guards
- Isolate utilities if at risk from flood water
  - extension cables on floor?
- Move & feed animals/livestock
- Evacuate before loss of access/egress



#### • Flood Plan in case marooned:

- 'Grab bag': documents, medication, battery/power bank, torch
- Raise/move furniture/valuables
- Safe lighting (not candles!) Have one plug in phone (not electric)
- Nutritious food (can eat cold); long life milk etc.
- Toilet paper/sanitary products



# **Flood Water**

#### • Hazards

- 'hydrology'
- missing pit covers
- Contamination: wastes, chemicals, Weils disease
- Walking
  - hazards and flow. Waders!
- 'Flood tourism' & recreation
  - walking/running near water (slips/falls)
  - Not a play ground (strainers kayak death)







# **Flood water**

#### • Driving

- Bow waves into properties!
- Avoidable damage to/loss of vehicles.
- DON'T IGNORE ROAD CLOSURES
- Stranded drivers/passengers places unnecessary demand on ES





## Don't drive into floodwater

Even if it looks shallow you can put yourself and your passengers at risk

  - manual handling
  - DIY injuries
  - utilities
  - exhaust fumes petrol pumps
- Restoration
  - design out/build in
