PUBLIC NOTICE OF MAKING

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(1)

**HEREFORDSHIRE COUNCIL
PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL14 (PART) CLIFFORD,
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2022**

NOTICE is hereby given that the County of Herefordshire District Council, known as Herefordshire Council, has made an Order under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), the effect of which is to temporarily close the following public right of way:

Public Footpath CL14 at OS Grid Reference SO 2479 4414.

The Order for closure is required due to a damaged footbridge.

There are exemptions in the Order to permit pedestrian access (and/or vehicular access at the discretion of the statutory undertaker) to any land or premises having a frontage to the above said highway affected where there is no other form of access; and to any access allowing the necessary works to be undertaken.

There is no alternative route.

The Order comes into force on 12 April 2022 and will continue in force for a period not exceeding six months from the said above date of operation (unless extended upon the direction of the Secretary of State) or until any said works which it is proposed to be carried out have been completed, (whichever is the earlier), or until determined by the Herefordshire Council.

Any queries in relation to this proposed order can be directed Public Rights of Way and a copy of the proposed order and a plan may be inspected on the Council's website.
